Putin Munich Security Conference 10.2.2007

- criticized the United States "monopolistic dominance in global relations", and its "almost uncontained hyper use of force in international relations"
- emphasized how Russia perceived eastward expansion as a threat
- Stated that it is obvious that NATO expansion does not have any relation with the modernisation of the Alliance itself or with ensuring security in Europe. On the contrary, it represents a serious provocation that reduces the level of mutual trust.
- We have the right to ask: against whom is this expansion intended?

May 2023 Pope Francis

- NATO may have caused Russia's invasion of Ukraine

Other broken promises

- March 2021: Sauli Niinistö new OSCE Summit – Helsinki 2025 – OSCE 50 years anniversary
- Indication of strong commitment for dialogue
- Support letter from some 140 NGOs in the Baltic Sea region
- November 2021 Finland was appointed chair of OSCE 2025
- February 2022 Ukraine invasion + NATO fever
- April 2022 new support letter incl. big international NGOs – Pekka Haavisto audience – no clear answers about a Summit

RECONSTRUCTING PEACE

- emphasize NATO's history and role as a warmonger, war participant, global nuclear weapons alliance
- support all initiatives for peace in Ukraine and elsewhere – 55 conflicts going on in the world
- require new disarmament negotiations and diplomacy at all levels
- require a nuclear-weapon-free zone in Europe and elsewhere (TPNW)




BRICS – the Johannisburg Declaration August 28.8.23

China, Brazil, Russia, India, South Africa + new ones: Saudi Arabia, Iran, Ethiopia, Egypt, Argentina, United Arab Emirates

- The BRICS countries represent
 - 43% of the world's population
 - 16% of the world trade
 - a larger share of the world's GDP than the G7
 - nineteen additional countries are reportedly interested in joining the alliance
