

MIKSI NÄISTÄ EI KIRJOITETA?

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Arvoisat vastaanottajat

Miten syvälle Suomen ja Euroopan täytyy vajota ennen kuin poliitikot heräävät ja media alkaa hoitamaan tehtävänsä demokraattisesti toimivan yhteiskunnan periaatteiden mukaisesti, eli kirjoittamaan monipuolisesti äärimmäisen, koko maailmaa uhkaavasta vakavasta sotaisasta ja taloudellisesta ja tilanteesta?

Ilman minkäänlaista syvällistä julkista keskustelua Suomi on NATO huumassaan sallimassa NATO:n pysyviä tukikohtia maaperällemme sekä ydinaseita Suomen Venäjän rajalle, joka on lähempänä Moskovaa kuin mikään muu Euroopan maa joka isännöi USA:n ydinaseita. Suomi Venäjän naapurivaltiona muodostaisi näin ollen suurimman vaaran Venäjälle, jos se liitetään NATO:on ja hyväksyy USA:n ydinaseita maaperällään.

Venäjän ydinaseet iskisivät Suomeen alle minuutissa.

Hän (Aleksei Žuravljov väitti), että Pietari - Putinin syntymäpaikka - voisi olla NATO:n ensimmäinen kohde sodassa Venäjän kanssa...

Jos suomalaiset haluavat tuhota osan väestöstämme, jos he iskevät Pietariin, se uhkaa tuhota koko Suomen valtiona'..."

Mutta USA ei pyri tuhoamaan Eurooppaa ainoastaan ydinaseillaan vaan myös taloudellisesti.

Philip Cunliffen (Associate Professor of International Relations at the Institute of Risk and Disaster Reduction, University College London), sekä monen muun vastuullisen asiantuntijan mukaan, Washingtonin Venäjän vastainen pakotepolitiikka tähtää Euroopan teollisuuden alasajoon.

Euroopan energiahintojen noustessa kattoon Washington tarjoaa pakenevalle Euroopan teollisuudelle suotuisia liiketoimintaehtoja.

Suomi ja Eurooppa kulkee sokkona kohti tulevaisuutta, jossa kansalaisten etuja uhrataan poliitikkojen vallanhimon, USA:n geopoliittisten ja taloudellisten intressien sekä sotateollisuuden alttarilla.
