KIISTANALAINEN UKRAINAN POLITIIKKA

- Yksi Ukrainan johtavista historioitsijoista ja valtiotieteilijöistä, Konstantin Bondarenko, paljastaa uudessa kirjassaan totuuden Ukrainasta, jonka valtamedia on jättänyt huomiotta. Linkki 3
- Venäjä arvostelee Yhdysvaltoja Ukrainan biolaboratorioista ja vaatii enemmän tekoja kuin tyhjiä sanoja. Linkki 7

GAZA ON PELASTETTAVA

- Kansainvälisten järjestöjen yhteinen vetoomus Gazan nälänhädän torjumiseksi: "Käynnistä diplomaattinen humanitaarinen saattue nyt!"
 18. toukokuuta 2025 allekirjoittaneiden organisaatioiden määrä on noussut 761:een. Naiset Rauhan Puolesta Suomi on sijalla 290. Linkki 4
- YK:n pääsihteeri António Guterres on erityisen huolissaan siitä, että valtaosa Gazan lapsista kärsii äärimmäisestä ruokapulasta. Tämän vahvistavat nyt 17 YK:n järjestöä ja kansalaisjärjestöä IPC:n raportissa. Viimeisimmän analyysin mukaan 470 000 Gazan ihmistä kohtaa katastrofaalista nälkää ja koko väestö kärsii akuutista ruokaturvattomuudesta.

Tämän lisäksi Israel kehtaa kohdistaa iskut säännöllisesti hyväntekeväisyyskeittiöihin, pakolaisleireihin, kouluihin, sairaaloihin, niin kutsuttuihin "humanitaarisiin alueisiin" ja muihin siviilien kokoontumisiin. Linkit 5, 11 ja 13

- Israel muuttaa Gazan kiellettyjen aseiden koekentäksi. Niin sanottujen "ei-tavanomaisten" aseiden toistuvan käytön myötä on raportoitu outoja ja kauhistuttavia ilmiöitä. Asiantuntijat uskovat tämän viittaavan lämpö- ja kemiallisten aseiden käyttöön.

Lisäksi Israelin armeija testaa uusia Bar-raketteja Gazassa. Israelin armeijan mukaan Bar-raketeissa on "vaikeisiin taisteluolosuhteisiin erityisesti suunniteltu ohjausmekanismi", joka pystyy myös osumaan kohteisiin "hyvin lyhyessä ajassa". Linkit 14 ja 21

Polish PM Donald Tusk unveiled on Thursday a bold plan to boost Baltic Sea security and expand Poland's ports.

The programme, called the "Polish Sea" plan, aims to protect regional waters and triple the amount of cargo passing through Polish ports by 2030. ...

Tusk said a new container terminal planned for Świnoujście, near the German border, would go ahead. "No one will block it – rest assured," he said. The initiative is a response to growing threats from Moscow and includes the creation of a coordinated NATO-backed Baltic Watch, to help patrol regional waters. …

Reuters – May 16, 2025 - Rubio says NATO members will agree to 5% defense spending over next decade by June summit

WASHINGTON, May 15 (Reuters) - U.S. Secretary of State Marco Rubio said on Thursday that all NATO members will have agreed on a goal of spending the equivalent to 5% of GDP on defense over the next decade by the 2025 NATO Summit in June.

He made the comments while appearing on Fox News' "Hannity."

... "I can tell you that we are headed for a summit in six weeks, in which virtually every member of NATO will be at or above 2% but more importantly, many of them will be over 4% and all will have agreed on the goal of reaching 5% over the next decade," said Rubio.

German Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul said this week that Berlin backed a demand by Trump for members of the defence alliance to increase defence spending to 5% of gross domestic product (GDP).

8) DW (Deutsche Welle) – May 15, 2025 - Germany backs 5% NATO defense spending target

After meeting with his US counterpart at a gathering of NATO foreign ministers in Turkey, Germany's foreign minister said Berlin is willing to "follow" US President's Trump's demand for increased defense spending.

... German Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul said on Thursday that Berlin accepts in principle the demand from the United States that NATO member states increase defense spending to 5% of GDP.

Speaking on the sidelines of an informal gathering of NATO foreign ministers in Antalya, Turkey, Wadephul said: "The result is the 5% that President [Donald] Trump has called for, and we will follow him in this respect."

NATO members are currently committed to spending at least 2% of GDP on military expenditure, a target which around one third of the alliance still doesn't meet, including Portugal (1.55%), Italy (1.49%), Canada (1.37%), Belgium (1.3%) and Spain (1.28%).

After a long tug-of-war between the European Commission and The New York Times over transparency surrounding the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine contracts, the European Court of Justice (ECJ) today ruled that the Commission "has not given a plausible explanation to justify the non-possession of the requested documents." ...

The former EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell has launched a blistering attack on <u>Israel</u>, accusing its government of committing genocide in Gaza and "carrying out the largest ethnic-cleansing operation since the end of the second world war in order to create a splendid holiday destination".

Borrell, a former Spanish foreign minister who served as the EU's top diplomat from 2019 to 2024, and president of the European parliament from 2004 to 2007, also criticised the bloc's failure to use all the means at its disposal to influence Israel, saying expressions of regret were simply not enough.

In an interview with Israeli outlet Ynet on Thursday, Moshe Yaalon, who also served as Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's defence minister between 2013 and 2016, said Israel had abandoned the captives held by Hamas and was carrying out a campaign of "ethnic cleansing" in Gaza.

Yaalon attacked the current military chief of staff, Eyal Zamir, saying he was not stopping "clearly illegal orders" and was ordering "his soldiers to be war criminals".

With the country's debt approaching 100% of GDP, Ukraine's Minister of Finance Serhiy Marchenko boasted about the possibility of shifting the burden of debt payments to European taxpayers, APA reports citing Sputnik International. "Most of this debt was borrowed during the war on soft terms from our partners. That is, we are talking about the fact that in the NEXT 30 YEARS we will not repay these debts," he said.

The total amount of Ukraine's state and state-guaranteed debt as of September 2024 was \$155.69 billion, including the \$112.06 billion of external debt, according to data released by the Ukrainian Ministry of Finance. ...

MIDDLE EAST MONITOR - April 29, 2025 - Israel army tests new Bar rockets in Gaza

The 282nd Artillery Regiment used Bar rockets, developed by Elbit Systems, to strike targets in southern Gaza as part of the ongoing offensive against Palestinians.

According to the Israeli army, the Bar rockets feature a "guidance mechanism specifically designed for difficult combat environments" which are also capable of hitting targets in a "very short period of time".

The Bar rockets are slated to replace the Israeli army's aging Rumach rockets, which are fired from the M270 multiple rocket launcher system.

Israel's genocidal campaign in the besieged Gaza Strip has become a lucrative marketing tool for the country's thriving weapons industry.

Experts explained that the deployment of advanced weaponry, such as suicide drones, smart guns and robot dogs, since October 2023 has not only wreaked

devastation on Gaza and its people, but has also served as a homegrown weapons-testing laboratory for Israeli companies. ...
