POLITICO – August 11, 2025 - Swiss lawmakers turn against F-35 deal after Trump's tariff bombshell

Trump's decision to hit Switzerland with a massive 39 percent tariff is causing a rethink on whether to buy the U.S. jet fighter.

An order for 36 F-35 jets may become a casualty of Donald Trump's trade war against Switzerland as political opposition to the multibillion-franc defense deal surges in Bern.

... "The U.S. only guarantees that buyers like Switzerland pay the same conditions as the U.S. military," Balthasar Glättli, a lawmaker for the Swiss Greens, said in an email to POLITICO. "But those prices can still rise — especially now that imported components into the U.S. are being hit with tariffs." ...

... "The F-35 fighter jets have now become a political issue again," Hans-Peter Portmann, a liberal lawmaker from the same party as President Karin Keller-Sutter, told Swiss media.

"In the current situation, we cannot simply carry on as if nothing had happened. The question is whether we should pull the ripcord," he said.

"Either we accept a loss and terminate the contract — or we only take delivery of what we have already paid for, stop the next delivery tranches from the U.S. and fill our defense gaps with purchases from Europe. This now needs to be carefully examined."

Gallup – August 7, 2025 – Ukrainian Support for War Effort Collapses

Public sours on Washington, loses hope for quick NATO accession

LONDON — Most Ukrainians now favor ending the war with Russia through negotiations, as support for fighting until victory has dropped sharply since the early days of the conflict. Although their hopes for joining NATO and the European Union have faded and approval of U.S. leadership has plummeted, Ukrainians still see the EU, U.K. and U.S. as key to ending the war. Yet, most doubt that will happen anytime soon. More than three years into the war, Ukrainians' support for continuing to fight until victory has hit a new low. In Gallup's most recent poll of Ukraine — conducted in early July — 69% say they favor a negotiated end

to the war as soon as possible, compared with 24% who support continuing to fight until victory. ...

Mondoweiss – August 6, 2025 - How U.S. imperialism blackmails the world with nuclear weapons, from Hiroshima to today

Since the US dropped an atomic bomb on Hiroshima on August 6, 1945, US imperialism has driven nuclear proliferation worldwide. Current nuclear flashpoints, such as Iran, show how the US continues to use nuclear blackmail to reinforce its dominance.

During the Cold War, the United States pursued a strategy of “nuclear superiority,” particularly after the Soviet Union ended America’s nuclear monopoly. This included stationing of “tactical” nuclear weapons systems that blurred the lines between conventional and nuclear warfare. ...

Today on the Eastern Europe front, like in the era of Cold War stand-offs between the Soviet Union and U.S., the crisis is just as volatile. The U.S. stations around 200 tactical nuclear weapons across Italy, Germany, Turkiye, Belgium, and the Netherlands, while Russia has around 2000 nuclear warheads deployed, dramatically increasing the risk of escalation from the current conflict in Ukraine to a nuclear war. These “tactical nuclear weapons” are designed for short-range use with less explosive yield while still being extremely destructive. ...

From 15–16 July 2025, thirty states met in Bogotá, Colombia at an Emergency Conference on Palestine, which was convened jointly by Colombia and South Africa as co-chairs of the Hague Group. The Hague Group, which began organizing in January 2025, formed as a bloc of countries to coordinate legal and diplomatic measures in solidarity with the Palestinian people. The Hague Group is comprised of Bolivia, Colombia, Cuba, Honduras, Malaysia, Namibia, and South Africa. ...

The 12 states are encouraging other countries to join them in similar commitments, urging them to do so by 20 September 2025, the start of the next UN General Assembly. What he witnessed goes beyond medicine — it raises questions about humanity, the moral cost of war, and the toll it takes not just on the bereaved and wounded, but on those trying to save them as well.

"...First of all it is a different situation that Ukraina and Russa is at war. It is two sovereign states, both have armies and both have arms and the actual playing field, the picture, a lot more level. The infrastructure is still standing in Ukraine, there are still roads, there is street lightning, there is still food, there is still hospitals and health care. That is not the situation in Gaza. So I think there is a huge moral difference between what is going on in Ukraine and what is going on in Gaza since there seems to be a purpose to wipe out the civilian population in Gaza

Carl Bildt, Co-Chair European Council on Foreign Relations, former prime minister and foreign minister of Sweden.

... Money will certainly shape Europe's future, as political leaders across the continent are forced to make painful decisions about how to allocate public funds in an increasingly unstable world. ...

Meeting all of these commitments will not be easy, especially for governments already grappling with high deficits and rising public debt. My guess is that Northern European countries will reach NATO's 3.5%-of-GDP defense spending target well before 2035, while Southern European countries – with the exception of Greece – will likely fail to meet it. With France, Italy, and Spain all heading for elections by 2027, the political appetite for the spending cuts needed to increase defense budgets will likely remain limited. ...

WIESBADEN, Germany — The U.S. Army and its [NATO allies](#) are embarking on the execution of a new “Eastern Flank Deterrence Line” plan that aims to enhance ground-based capabilities and drive military-industrial interoperability across the alliance, the U.S. Army Europe and Africa commander said Wednesday at the Association of the U.S. Army’s inaugural LandEuro conference in Wiesbaden, Germany. ...

For example, Donahue noted, Kaliningrad, Russia, is roughly 47 miles wide and surrounded by NATO on all sides and the Army and its allies now have the capability to “take that down from the ground in a timeframe that is unheard of and faster than we’ve ever been able to do.”
