UKRAINAN UUSIA KÄÄNTEITÄ

- * Ruotsin puolustusvoimien komentaja kenraali Michael Claesson on sanonut, että Venäjä testaa pian Naton artiklan 5 mukaista kollektiivista puolustussopimusta ja Euroopan on oltava valmis käyttämään voimaa Moskovan pelottelemiseksi.
- * Entinen merivoimien komentaja, amiraali lordi West, antoi vakavan varoituksen ydinaseuhkista ja sanoi Britannian olevan jo "käytännössä sodassa" Vladimir Putinin Venäjän kanssa.
- * Ukraina on 100 miljoonan dollarin korruptioskandaalin keskellä.
- * Sotilaslääkärit kertoivat The Telegraphille, että droonisodankäynti on tehnyt haavoittuneiden sotilaiden evakuoinnista lähes mahdotonta luoden olosuhteet, jotka aiheuttavat tartuntojen lisääntymistä. Linkit 1, 5, 6 ja 12

Evarist kirjoitti hiljattain artikkelin Euroopan "yhteisen kodin kangastuksesta" ja siitä, miten Yhdysvallat on aina vastustanut yleiseurooppalaista turvallisuusrakennetta. Hän tuo esille omiin kokemuksiinsa nojaten hämmästyttäviä kertomuksia EU:n neuvoston kokouksista, joissa taistelua suosittiin keskustelun sijaan. *Linkki 13*

GAZASSA ANKARAT AJAT

Viime viikolla Gazassa kuoli kymmeniä palestiinalaisia Isrealin iskuissa. Israel iski myös Libanoniin, armeijan mukaan Hamas käytti paikkaa suunnitellakseen ja toteuttaakseen iskuja Israelia vastaan, jotka Hamas kiisti.

Sääolosuhteet Gazassa vaihtelevat ja tuulet ja myrskyt vievät telttoja mukanaan. Satojentuhansien Gazan kaistalla siirtymään joutuneiden palestiinalaisten kärsimys pahenee. *Linkit 3, 4 ja 8*

MAAILMAN JOHTAJAT PERUSTAKAA KANSAINVÄLINEN ERIARVOISUUSPANEELI (IPC)

Yli 600 taloustieteilijää ja eriarvoisuuden asiantuntijaa yli 70 maasta, kehotti G20 kokousta tukemaan pysyvän kansainvälisen epätasa-arvopaneelin perustamista.

Ryhmä tuki Stiglitz G20 -komitean näkemystä siitä, että maailmalla on edessään eriarvoisuushätätila. He ovat syvästi huolissaan siitä, että äärimmäiset vaurauden keskittymät johtavat epädemokraattisiin vallan keskittymiin, jotka purkavat luottamusta yhteiskuntiimme ja polarisoivat politiikkaamme. *Linkki 10*

KARIBIAN ALUE

Puerto Ricossa pitkään toimimattomana ollut Yhdysvaltain tukikohta on aktivoitu uudelleen, mikä on käynnistänyt suurimman alueellisen sotilaallisen vahvistumisen vuosikymmeniin.

Alueelle on saapunut maailman suurin lentotukialus, USS Gerald R. Fordin. Trump väittää, että alueella olevat veneet kuljettavat huumeita Yhdysvaltoihin.

Jotkut asiantuntijat epäilevät, että todellinen tavoite on tukea mahdollista Yhdysvaltojen sotilasiskua, jonka tarkoituksena on kaataa Nicolás Maduron hallinto Venezuelassa. *Linkit 7 ja 9*

NATO MYRKYTTÄJÄNÄ JA SAASTUTTAJANA

Vuonna 1999 NATO käytti köyhdytettyjä uraaniammuksia Kosovon sodassa. Lukuisat italialaiset sotilaat sairastuivat myöhemmin syöpään, ja joillekin myönnettiin korvauksia.

Sardiniassa on Euroopan suurin sotilasharjoitusalue, jossa testattiin tuhansia uraanikärkisiä ohjuksia. Nyt suhteettoman suuri määrä syöpiä sekä kammottavien epämuodostumien kanssa syntyneitä lapsia ja karjaa on johtanut syytöksiin NATO:n saaren saastumisen laajuuden salailusta. *Linkit 14 ja 15*

1) THE KYIV INDEPENDENT – November 20, 2025 – Ukraine war latest: Russia will test NATO's Article 5 soon, top Swedish general warns

Russia will soon test NATO's Article 5 collective defense treaty and Europe must be prepared to use force to deter Moscow, <u>Swedish</u> Chief of Defense Gen. Michael Claesson has said.

"I'm sure and I'm convinced that they would be ready to test <u>Article 5 of NATO</u> at any point in the Baltic states or in some other part of Europe as well," he said in an interview with Politico published Nov. 19.

"They are prepared to take enormous strategic risks to gain whatever they see possible to gain — we have seen it since Chechnya, we have seen it in Georgia, we have seen it in Crimea."

Claesson also said Europe was not prepared either mentally or militarily for a war with Russia, which he described as "a systemic conflict... that will take a long time to solve." ...

2) FRANCE24 - November 20, 2025 - US peace plan asks Ukraine to cede territory, government source says

A new US peace proposal for <u>Ukraine</u> would see Kyiv ceding land and more than halving its army, a source told AFP Wednesday, as a Russian strike in the west of the country killed 26 people, including three children.

The proposal appears to repeat <u>Russia</u>'s maximalist terms to end the war – demands consistently rejected by Ukraine as tantamount to capitulation.

The surprise initiative comes as Russian missiles hit the western city of Ternopil, far from the front line, in one of the deadliest attacks on western Ukraine since the invasion began in 2022.

Meanwhile, Ukrainian President <u>Volodymyr Zelensky</u>'s efforts to re-engage US President Donald Trump's administration in the peace process during a surprise visit to Turkey fell flat after an American envoy thought to be joining him did not make the trip. ...

THE CONVERSATION – November 14, 2025 - Trump's Latin America strategy risks creating a military quagmire

The arrival of the world's largest aircraft carrier, the USS Gerald R. Ford, in the Caribbean basin on November 11 has intensified fears of a large-scale conflict in the region. The carrier has been deployed as part of US president Donald Trump's campaign against boats in the Caribbean and Pacific allegedly transporting drugs bound for the US.

But some experts suspect that the real objective is to support a possible US military strike aimed at <u>toppling the regime</u> of Nicolás Maduro in Venezuela. ...

The IPI is the central recommendation of the <u>G20's first ever report on global inequality</u>, which will be presented to leaders at next week's G20 Leaders Summit in Johannesburg.

They may lack Labour's party machine, but Zack Polanski's burgeoning popularity could have seismic consequences for British politics

... In the <u>most recent YouGov poll</u>, the Greens are still four points behind Labour. But that's down from 12 points in August, just before Polanski was elected, and other polls have put them almost at parity. If both parties stick to their current trajectories – Labour drowning in pre-budget gloom and recriminations and the Greens surfing an optimistic wave of voters looking for a British equivalent to New York's upbeat new socialist mayor-elect Zohran Mamdani – then the psychologically important crossover point could be only weeks away. Though polls are only ever a snapshot of a moment in time, revealing very little about the results of a general election that could still be four years away, that would nonetheless be a seismic moment. ...

Military medics say Russian drone strikes make evacuation almost impossible – creating conditions that cause infections to surge

Ukrainian medics are reporting cases of gas gangrene, a condition once closely associated with the trenches of the First World War and long thought to have been all but eradicated in Europe.

The bacterial infection, which destroys muscle tissue at a deadly pace, has made a resurgence in Ukraine due to the harsh realities of modern trench warfare. Military medics told The Telegraph that drone warfare has made evacuating wounded soldiers almost impossible – conditions that are causing infections once consigned to the history books to spread with alarming speed. ...

DW (Deutsche Welle) – November 7, 2025 - Depleted uranium: The forgotten legacy of the Kosovo War

In 1999, NATO used uranium ammunition during the Kosovo War. Numerous soldiers subsequently developed cancer, and some were awarded compensation. In Kosovo, the soil remains poisonous to this day.

"I can vividly remember the last day," said Emerico Maria Laccetti, former colonel of the military division of Italian Red Cross.

During the Kosovo War in 1999, he was stationed in <u>Albania</u>, just a few hundred meters from the border with <u>Kosovo</u>. He was the commander of a field hospital for refugees from the province, which at the time belonged to <u>Serbia</u>.

"We stood on containers and watched the bombings," he said. "It was like a perverse New Year's Eve fireworks display. Even at a distance, you could feel the air pressure, the shock waves going through your body. But no, we were not told about the specific dangers of the weapons being used."

... In response to questions about the health risks posed by DU ammunition, NATO only gave a written statement. "We take health and environmental issues very seriously," it said.

In 2001, a committee on DU concluded that the use of DU ammunition in Kosovo "did not cause any lasting health risk to the population," citing independent findings.

NATO refers to UN reports from 2014. "This is scientific evidence; it was reliable, and we stand by it," the military alliance said in a statement.

However, this contradicts the rulings of Italian courts on lawsuits filed by approximately 500 Kosovo War veterans who developed cancer after coming into contact with depleted uranium ammunition. ...
