Ankaran kuvernöörin toimisto kielsi kaikki julkiset yleiskokoukset ja mielenosoitukset ja toimet, kuten lehtisten jakamisen ja bannereiden näyttämisen keskiyöstä 28. kesäkuuta keskiyöhön 10. heinäkuuta.

Human Rights Watch (FMT/AFP) – June 26, 2026 - Türkiye: Crackdown Ahead of NATO Summit

Hundreds Detained, Protests Banned, Social Media Accounts Blocked

The arrest of at least 209 people in the [Turkish](#) capital, Ankara, ahead of the July 7-8, 2026 NATO summit there highlights Türkiye's ruthless intolerance of freedom of speech and assembly, Human Rights Watch said today.

In raids overnight between June 22 and 23, the police arrested people including political activists, lawyers, an academic, and a journalist who is a [prominent LGBT rights activist](#). The [Ankara prosecutor's office said](#) on June 23 that the arrests were to "decipher the action and activities of terrorist organizations," and linked those arrested to revolutionary leftist groups and to the Islamic State (ISIS) without providing details of any alleged crimes or criminal activity.

"The misuse of terrorism laws to conduct mass arrests and silence people in the run-up to a NATO summit flies in the face of the founding [values](#) of the alliance," said [Benjamin Ward](#), deputy Europe and Central Asia director at Human Rights Watch. "The authorities should immediately release those detained, and NATO should insist that peaceful expression and assembly must be permitted around the summit." ...

RESPONSIBLE STATECRAFT - June 26, 2026 – The Iran war is the most unpopular major conflict in US history

Polling shows that Trump's latest military adventure is even less-liked than the Vietnam war

During an April Senate hearing dominated by debate over the [Iran](#) war, Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth batted down criticisms from skeptical members of Congress, [saying](#) "I believe we do have the support of the American people" in this conflict.

Hegseth, it turns out, was wrong. Two months later, we can now confidently say that the Iran conflict is the most unpopular war in U.S. history.

When I [compared](#) public opinion on the Iran War to previous major U.S. conflicts in May, it hadn't quite reached the Vietnam War's level of unpopularity.

But [polling](#) from June shows that the Iran War has now sunk to negative 32% net support — below the negative 31% recorded in the final poll during Vietnam. This means that 32 percentage points more people oppose the Iran War than support it. ...

... CND is calling on the government to stop wasting public money on its nuclear black hole, after the latest nuclear weapons [spending report](#) from the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN) reveals that Britain is now spending more on its nuclear weapons than Russia.

Collectively, the nine nuclear-weapon states spent a record \$119 billion in 2025 on maintaining, modernising, and expanding their nuclear arsenals, an increase of 19% (\$16.8 billion) on their 2024 bill.

Britain overtook Russia as the world's third biggest spender, spending \$12.6 billion (£9.6 billion), an increase of 17%. ...

International anti-war conference in London attracts 3,000 activists. Spending on the arms build-up is dismantling social welfare systems. Protests grow louder across Europe. EU imposes draconian sanctions on individuals.

LONDON/PARIS/BRUSSELS (our own report) – A new movement against the unprecedented militarisation across Europe is gaining momentum as international protests widen and anti-war conferences set the resistance agenda. On 14 June, some 12,000 people took to the street in Brussels under the banner 'Welfare, not Warfare!' in response to massive rearmament programmes. Social welfare systems are being dismantled across Europe to finance militarisation.

The Brussels demonstration was followed on Saturday by a major international anti-war conference in London, attended by nearly 3,000 people from Europe, North America and the Middle East. The discussion highlighted the West's brutal war policies and the dramatic collapse of healthcare, education and pensions. "Austerity and militarisation" are "two sides of the same coin", declared the president of the British food industry union, the BFAWU. Further Europe-wide protests are planned for the coming autumn, including a day of action by dockworkers. ...

Morning Star – June 21, 2026 - Thousands gather for union-backed International Conference Against War

THOUSANDS of activists from around the world gathered at Westminster's Central Hall on Saturday for an international conference against war organised by the Stop the War Coalition.

The London conference was backed by 11 trade unions and over 1,100 individual signatories, drawing attendees from 23 countries.

Among the leading anti-war campaigners were Medea Benjamin of Code Pink and Amara Enyia of the Movement for Black Lives from the US, Palestinian physician and MP Mustafa Barghouti and French MP Jerome Legavre.

Chairing the opening session, ex-president of transport union RMT Alex Gordon said: *"The gathering is part of a movement against the militarisation of Europe."*

Ulrike Eifler of the German union IG Metall said there was a mass industrial crisis in her country with huge numbers of job losses; the answer of the German government was to expand the military.

"Rearmament is not the way to rebuild industry," she said.

Four weeks ago the German union federation DGB rejected moves towards conscription in Germany. *"This means that at a time when an entire generation is being prepared for war, the unions have taken a stand,"* she said. ...

Over the next fifteen years, Germany is set to become an internationally leading aviation nation. This is spelled out in a new aviation strategy recently adopted by the Federal Government. The strategy document emphasises the value of developing independent European and German aerospace capabilities. Crucially, the approach taken is, for the first time, centred on closer collaboration between civil and military aviation development. Policymakers are putting resources into the goal of rapidly advancing German drone capabilities. The plan is ambitious: Germany should in future be "*a European leader*" – "*in the research, development and production of cutting-edge military aviation technologies.*"...

Suomi on liittynyt tekoälyn, puolijohteiden ja kriittisten mineraalien toimitusketjuja turvaavaan Pax Silica -aloitteeseen. Suomen puolesta julistuksen allekirjoitti elinkeinoministeri Sakari Puisto Washingtonissa 16.4.2026.

Pax Silica kokoaa yhteen maailman johtavia teknologiamaita. Aloite on Yhdysvaltain joulukuussa 2025 käynnistämä kansainvälinen strateginen kumppanuus, jonka tavoitteena on turvata tekoälyn, puolijohteiden ja kriittisten mineraalien toimitusketjut. Samalla se edistää innovaatioita, vahvistaa turvallista digitaalista infrastruktuuria ja suojaa herkkiä teknologioita.

*"Yhdysvallat on Suomelle keskeinen liittolainen. Pax Silican kautta voimme edelleen syventää ulko- ja turvallisuuspoliittista, taloudellista sekä teknologista yhteistyötämme. Samalla aloite tarjoaa Suomelle mahdollisuuden vahvistaa taloudellista turvallisuutta muiden osallistujamaiden kanssa", toteaa ulkoministeri **Elina Valtonen**.*

"Suomi on vahva teknologia- ja innovaatiomaa, jolla on korkeatasoista tutkimusta ja kansainvälisesti kilpailukykyisiä yrityksiä. Aloite vahvistaa suomalaisten yritysten mahdollisuuksia yhteistyölle Yhdysvalloissa ja avaa myös uusia mahdollisuuksia aloilla, joissa Suomella on vahvuuksia", sanoo elinkeinoministeri Sakari Puisto.

Aloitteeseen on liittynyt jo noin kymmenkunta maata, muun muassa Ruotsi, Australia, Intia, Japani, ja Yhdistynyt kuningaskunta.
