Pascal's Substack (Neutrality Studies) – July 13, 2026 – Finland and the Results of Elite Capture

Europe's irrational choices are the outcome of decades of US "elite capture," Finnish writer Olli Tammilehto argues. No better example than the president of his own country, Alexander Stubb.

Finland's Irrational Choice

States are generally thought to pursue their own security and economic interests. However, in recent years, several European countries have made decisions that are clearly against their own interests but promote US interests. For example, Finland has concluded a so-called Defense Cooperation Agreement (DCA) with the United States. According to the agreement, the US gets access to 15 existing Finnish military bases and can build its own bases inside them. One of them will be in Lapland, close to Russia's main nuclear submarine base. By making Finland the first target of Russian missiles and increasing tensions between the two nuclear powers, the DCA endangers Finland's security. Instead, the agreement promotes the long-term aspirations of the US administration, or deep state, which is independent of presidential changes. These include preventing the rise of rival great powers and related attempts to encircle, destabilize and weaken Russia. ...

Douglas Macgregor is a retired Colonel, combat veteran, and former senior advisor to the U.S. Secretary of Defense. Col. Macgregor discusses the NATO Summit.

...NATO summit takeaways: *"My takeaways are fairly straight forward. Once again I am always stunned by the complete lack of any strategic coherence in anything the Donald Trup says or does and that is what makes him entertaining. ... So I was suprised that he went back to Greenland and the criticality of occupying Greenland to keep all thos Chinese and Russian ships from somehow threatening the US via Greenland and Europe."*

Europe: *"I have some links to Germany - concern about all the non-Europeans they have, that they would like to rid themselves of that problem. You know that Germany, can say the same thing about Britain and US as well: The financial system can't support them much longer. So, they are on the verge of economic collapse. All you have to do is look at the numbers of people who can't find work in Germany. The numbers of people who depend entirely on checks from the government. Included the vast number of unwanted immigrants.*

What does war always do? War breeds inflation. And what do we do right now to try to cope with that? Well, we are raising interests. We really have no choice; we can't control that anymore. And if you look at the 10-years bonds in the US. This is very very important. Look at oil, inflation and the bond market for the interest rates. Oil has inched up to 80\$ a barrel. People think this is going to be on a yo-yo.

Hormuz closed, oil up. Opened, oil down. War on off, week for week. But the markets can't cope with that and eventually all the efforts of Trump and the financial gurus he is surrounded with, his billionaire friends ... well provoking oil shortage to suppress the cost of oil - it's not going to work anymore. the 10-years bonds are up to 4,5%. When that 10-year bond interest hits 5% we're through. We cannot service the debts. We cannot borrow any longer. The destruction of credit, which is inevitable at that point is going to bring everybody in the West down. That's where we are heading right now".

Europe could have used the meeting to show the U.S. how it will take the lead — instead it just agreed to buy a bunch of stuff.

Ivo Daalder, a former U.S. ambassador to NATO, is a senior fellow at Harvard University's Belfer Center and host of the weekly podcast "World Review with Ivo Daalder." He writes POLITICO's From Across the Pond column.

As NATO leaders head home from their annual summit in Ankara, it seems they concluded these meetings really aren't worth the effort — so long as Donald Trump is U.S. president.

They said just as much, ending the summit with a vague: "We look forward to our next meeting," rather than reaffirm they would come together in Albania next year, as planned.

And they are right. Ankara, in many ways, was a lost opportunity.

The grandly named "[Ankara Summit Declaration](#)" is a one-page, six-paragraph boilerplate statement that isn't worth the paper it was written on. And while [reports from inside](#) the three-hour leaders' meeting suggested Trump was genial and even praised allies for increasing their defense spending, he

unleashed a fusillade of invectives against those very same countries as soon as the cameras were on. ...

Drop Site News – July 9, 2026 - The Crimson Thread: The Israeli Military Barrier Cutting Off Palestine's Breadbasket

The first 22 kilometers of a planned 500-kilometer Israeli military barrier are cutting off Palestinians from a large swathe of some of the most fertile agricultural land in the occupied West Bank.

TUBAS, West Bank—Muad Abdelreziq walked slowly through his land on the Al-Forat farm, meandering through rows of banana groves on foot, checking each tree for signs of life. The dead leaves crunched underfoot with each slow, defeated step. No water had reached these groves in five days. "These bananas, they are thirsty," he said. "They are withering away on the ground."

"Everything on the land lives day by day."

Israel had not allowed water to reach 400 dunams (roughly 100 acres) of the farm for five days, Abdelreziq told Drop Site, and what little infrastructure remains is being destroyed. Israeli forces have been rupturing the irrigation pipelines that feed the fields. "I cannot irrigate the herbs, I cannot irrigate the melons," he said. "I cannot replace the water lines. All these families will have nothing. We will have to stop." ...

also says previous trade threats from Trump failed to materialize. The latest dispute comes after Trump criticized Spain over defence spending at the NATO summit, calling the country a *"terrible partner."* Otero believes the standoff is driven more by political differences between Trump and Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez than by economics.

Nato Secretary-General Mark Rutte on Monday demanded that allies put forward *"clear, concrete and credible plans"* to reach the organisation's spending targets, warning that those who do not step up would face consequences. *"If one or two still have to be convinced, we have ways to do that,"* Rutte said, without elaborating, ahead of a two-day summit starting Tuesday in Ankara. The summit

comes at a critical time for the alliance, with the United States scaling down its security role in Europe and President Donald Trump pressing allies to shoulder more of the spending burden. ...

International Peace Bureau – July 6, 2026 - IPB Statement on the Detention and Deportation of Executive Director Sean Conner and other Activists in Istanbul on 3 July 2026

The International Peace Bureau (IPB) unequivocally condemns the detention and deportation of its Executive Director, Sean Conner, alongside other activists from Germany, Finland, and Italy. Upon arrival at Istanbul's Sabiha Gökçen International Airport at 17:27 local time on Friday, 3 July, Sean had his passport and cell phone confiscated and was subjected to two hours of interrogation, including scans of his fingerprints and mugshot photographs. Turkish authorities repeatedly lied about the reasons for the interrogation and claimed that the reason for the check was a flagging by the German authorities, who denied any involvement.

Sean then had all his belongings searched, including the confiscated phone, was coerced into signing paperwork for his own deportation – without context or explanation of what he was signing – and was forced into a detention room, at which point he was told he would be deported on a flight the following day. The same treatment was given to four activists from Linksjugend (Left Youth of Germany), one activist from Työväen antimilitaristit (Labor antimilitarists of Finland), as well as one from Fronte Popolare of Italy. Other activists faced interrogation but were ultimately allowed to enter.

Those detained were subject to psychological punishment and illegal practices, including an unsanitary environment and bright lights that prevented sleep, an inability to communicate with anyone outside the facility or to be aware of the time due to confiscation of all technology, and no explanation for the reason of detention or deportation. Passports were only returned to activists after landing in their country of departure, accompanied by threats of police escort upon return. ...

The Arab Weekly – July 6, 2026 - Turkey detains more than 100 people as leftist groups hold anti-NATO protests

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... Authorities have ramped up security measures across the Turkish capital ahead of the meeting, banning demonstrations, barricading large parts of the city and closing off roads.

In a statement, the TKP said it had organised the protest march in Ankara's central Kizilay square, adding that more than 100 party members, including administrators, had been detained.

Footage showed flag-waving protesters chanting slogans including "Murderer NATO, get out of country" and "No passage to NATO," as riot police intervened using tear gas to disperse crowds.

In a separate protest organised by the TKP, hundreds of people marched from Istanbul's Taksim Square to Dolmabahce. There were also two separate protests organised by leftist groups in the Kadikoy district. Despite a heavy police presence, there were no scuffles during the protests in Istanbul. ...

We are deeply concerned by a [recent report](#) of Ukrainian media about torturing to death a conscientious objector Dmytro Koval and other individuals, at least 26 in total, at Skelya assault regiment. Welcoming the announced start of official investigation, we emphasize that it is not enough to ensure accountability of perpetrators responsible for torture of conscientious objectors in [this and other cases](#). Ukraine must prevent repetition of such incidents by

changing current policy of attempts to violently force individuals to change their religion of belief incompatible with service in Armed Forces of Ukraine, contrary to Articles 7 and 18 (2) of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights that should be fully respected in time of war and cannot be derogated. ...

... "There are no talks going on with Russia. The Russians have concluded that the summit meeting in Anchorage was a farce, not serious. Trump never followed up any of the commitments it allegedly made and the Europeans are talking about war with Russia, not peace. Some of the Europeans are aiding and abetting the Ukrainian deep strikes into Russia which are an annoyance to Russia. ... But they basically did illustrate the Russian point that a hostile force

Hard power is needed to halt Tel Aviv's reckless quest to redraw the borders of the Middle East

... The Iran war was a [clear setback](#) to Israel's regional plans. But in an obvious sign that the war would have continued even if the US and Israel had achieved regime change in Tehran, the political establishment in Tel Aviv has now turned its attention to [Turkey](#).

As day follows night, Turkey has become Israel's latest existential enemy. As if in unison, a chorus of Israeli politicians has raised the alarm about a new "[Sunni axis](#)" opening up, composed of Turkey, [Syria](#) and [Qatar](#). ...

Firstly, the rhetoric against Turkey is bipartisan. It is the leitmotif of the man tipped to replace Netanyahu, Naftali Bennett, who has [said](#) that a new Turkish threat is emerging: "*I want to be very clear. Turkey and Qatar have gained influence in Syria, are seeking influence elsewhere and everywhere throughout the region, and from here I warn - Turkey is the new Iran.*"

The theme was picked up by [Amichai Chikli](#), the diaspora affairs minister, who said the era of the "Shia empire of Iran" was over. In its shoes, he added, walks a new axis: "*the Muslim Brotherhood axis of Erdogan's Turkey, Syria and Qatar. And it's better to open your eyes now.*" ...
